SA World Vets students are accommodated on a variety of **private game reserves** located in the heart of the African bushveld, just outside **Kruger National Park**. Accommodation arrangements may vary depending on the number of students in each session.

Students typically stay in **spacious en-suite chalets**, shared between **two students**, depending on the lodge. To accommodate the majority of participants, **separate male and female accommodation** is provided. Students are encouraged to indicate any housing preferences on their information form, and SA World Vets will accommodate requests where possible. **Private rooms** may be available on request for an additional fee, subject to availability. The lodges are equipped with Wi-Fi, supply bath towels and bottled water, and have a weekly laundry service.

The main lodge building includes a **fully equipped kitchen**, a **communal dining area**, and a **large outdoor patio with a fire pit**. Evenings are often spent here, relaxing and sharing experiences around the fire under the African night sky after full days in the field. Each lodge also features a **swimming pool**, which students may use during designated downtime.

All lodges are situated on active game reserves and are home to a variety of wildlife, including several antelope species and smaller mammals such as vervet monkeys, baboons, caracal, servals, genets, civets, porcupines, and honey badgers. Leopards are occasionally sighted, and some reserves are also home to Big Five species, such as buffalo. For safety reasons, **walking, running, or unsupervised movement on the reserve is strictly prohibited**.
