This course is designed for **veterinary (DVM) students or graduates**, as well as students in related fields from any accredited university. Related fields include **veterinary technology, veterinary nursing, zoology, wildlife conservation, and wildlife rehabilitation**. Applicants from other disciplines may be considered on a **case-by-case basis**.

To participate in the programme, students must meet the following requirements:

- Be physically able to endure long days in the field
- Hold valid medical insurance for the duration of the programme
- Be capable of moderate physical activity, including some lifting
- Obtain approval from their veterinary school if course credit is required
- Attend all required pre-departure meetings
- Demonstrate proficiency in the English language
- Have a current **rabies vaccination**

All students are expected to uphold the **highest standards of professionalism, ethical conduct, and academic integrity** at all times, in keeping with the expectations of the veterinary and conservation professions.
